



Block Party and Waterfront Busking Info

The block party is directly after the fursuit parade (which starts Saturday July 5th at 2:00pm.) It runs until approximately 10 pm.

We encourage musicians and performers to enjoy themselves. This is a chance to interact with the convention and town at large. We ask that folks be courteous and understand a few guidelines:

- Please do not block sidewalks when performing.
- There are no reserved locations. Please do not set up in the same space for more than 2 hours. Allow others to use the space too.
- Be aware when interacting with patrons in the outdoor eating areas. Some restaurants may not want a crowd directly against their space.
- Anthrocon is not aware of any required permits for busking. However, please obey any requests to move made by the city or property owners.
- You may busk for your own benefit. But you may not sell merchandise.
- If you would like to busk for the charity you have two options:
 - The charity (Nose 2 Tail Cat Rescue) has QR codes that allow people to donate directly to the charity. You can pick up a card or bucket with the code from the charity table.
 - To accept cash donations, a member of the charity will need to be present. (This is for liability reasons.) They plan to have representatives at the block party. For questions about coordination with the charity, please contact Stormy@anthrocon.org

The Riverfront Park is a public park and not “owned” by Anthrocon. It is controlled by the city of Pittsburgh.

- Non-convention users are allowed to use the waterfront park. Please be a good neighbor with them.
- Please do not block sidewalks and bike paths.
- If a police officer or other official asks you to do something, you should do it. This includes leaving the park when requested.
- The local noise ordinance has “quiet time” starting at 11pm.
